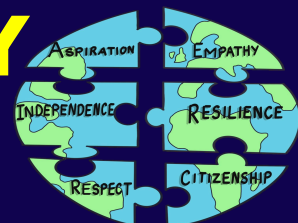

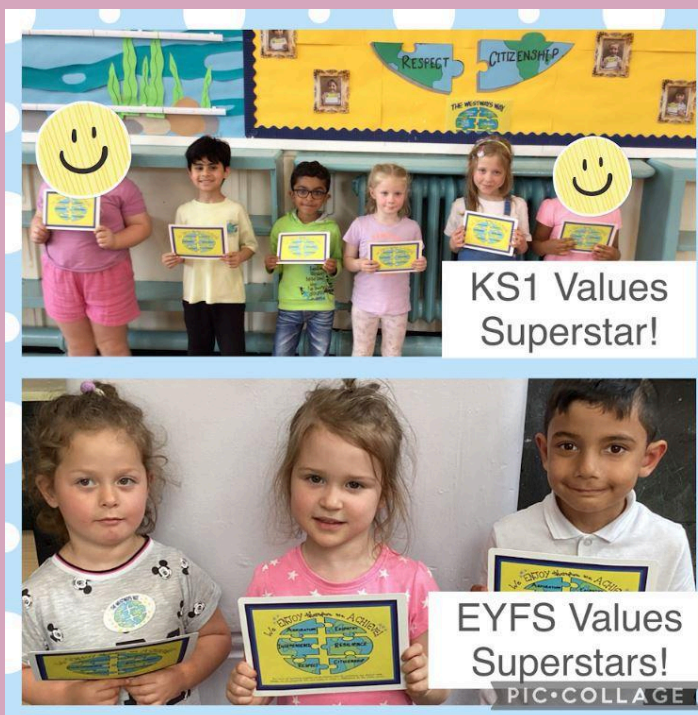

## School Meal Change

Schools have to produce a census to the Department for Education three times a year, which determines the amount of funding each school receives.

Part of that funding is calculated by the amount of school meals infant school children have on the day of the census. Next Thursday, 16th May is census day and in order to encourage all of our Reception and KS1 (Years 1 and 2) children to have a school meal, we have changed the menu to the following:

### Thursday 16th May

**Orange option** - Fish Fingers with Chips & Tomato Ketchup

**Purple option** - Cheese & Onion Puff Pastry Roll with Chips & Tomato Ketchup

**Yellow option** - Pasta with Tomato Sauce

There will be no green option

### Friday 17th May

**Orange option** - Chicken & Vegetable Burrito

**Purple option** - Cheese & Tomato Pizza with Garlic Bread

**Green option** - Halal Lamb Bolognese & Penne Pasta

**Yellow option** - Jacket Potato with Cheese, Beans or Tuna
