### Nursery Sports Day 2026 Wednesday 8th July

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are writing to tell you about this year's Nursery Sports Day on **Wednesday 8th July 2026**. There will be two Sports Day sessions to ensure all Nursery children get the chance to participate: a morning session and an afternoon session.

On the day, the children will take part in a series of multi-sports activities, play some team games and take part in some traditional races too. Unfortunately, we are asking parents and carers **not to attend** this event. Although we know you will be eager to watch your child at Sports Day, we feel the presence of lots of parents and carers will be slightly overwhelming for the children. However, we do plan to invite you into school next year for Sports Day when your child is in Reception.

#### Sports kit & footwear

Please ensure your child arrives at school on Sports Day in an appropriate sports kit. This can include:

- A t-shirt and possibly a jumper
- Shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings
- Appropriate footwear to allow them to run, jump and throw safely throughout the day

Also, please ensure **all jewellery is removed**. Where it is not possible to remove earrings, we ask that parents/carers make them safe prior to coming to school by taping, front and back, to offer a measure of protection.

#### Sun protection

Finally, we hope for good weather on Sports Day and recognise your child may spend a prolonged period of time in the sun. Unfortunately, staff are not able to apply sun cream to the children, so we encourage you to apply this to your child in the morning before arriving at school. We also advise that you send your child with a sun hat on the day if required.
