Dear Parent/Carer,

We are writing to tell you about this year's Sports Day on **Friday 10th July 2026**. We would like to invite you into school on the day from **9:30am to 11:45am** to watch the races part of the day.

Sports Day will take place on the Warwick playground. On the morning, we ask that you **enter school via the Warwick Street entrance** and stay within the designated areas to spectate. We also ask that you **do not take any photos or videos during Sports Day**. Instead, we will allow some time at the end of the Sports Day for you to take some photos of your child.

The main purpose of our Westways Sports Day is for the children to have fun, but we also like to include an element of competition. Therefore your child will be competing for their River Team (**Don**, **Porter**, **Rivelin** or **Sheaf**). Points from each event will be added together to help determine which River Team will be the Sports Day Champions this year - the winning team will be announced in a special assembly on the following week.

PE kit & footwear

As per our [Dress Code Policy](#), please ensure your child arrives at school on Sports Day in an appropriate PE kit. This can include:

- A Westways River Team t-shirt (alternatively a t-shirt the colour of their River Team) or a plain white t-shirt and possibly a jumper
 - If you would like to purchase a new River Team t-shirt, you can do this through [Imperial Sports](#)
- Plain black or navy shorts or jogging bottoms (leggings may also be worn)
- Appropriate footwear to allow them to run, jump and throw safely throughout the day

Also, please ensure **all jewellery is removed**. Where it is not possible to remove earrings, we ask that parents/carers make them safe prior to coming to school by taping, front and back, to offer a measure of protection.

Sun protection

Finally, we hope for good weather on Sports Day and recognise your child may spend a prolonged period of time in the sun. Unfortunately, staff are not able to apply sun cream to the children, so we encourage you to apply this to your child in the morning before arriving at school. We also advise that you send your child with a sun hat on the day if required.
