NHS Guidance on Mild Illness

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school when they're unwell.

There are government guidelines for schools and nurseries about managing specific infectious diseases, these say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't.

If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone school on the first day by 9am to let us know that your child won't be in and let us know the reason or alternatively email us on enquiries@westways.sheffield.sch.uk

If your child is well enough to come to school but has an infection that could be passed on, such as a cold sore or head lice, please let their teacher know.

If your child has diarrhoea or vomiting they should stay away from school for at least 48 hours after the last bout of illness.


