Schools have to produce a census to the Department for Education three times a year, which determines the amount of funding each school receives.

Year 2



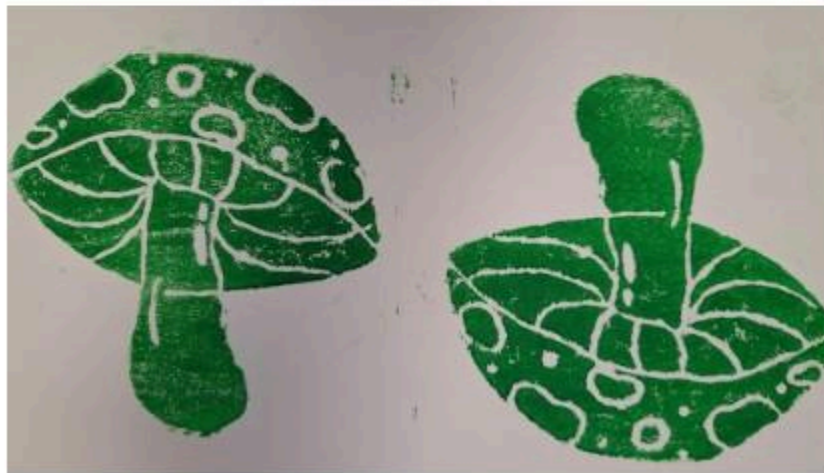
This week, Year 2 visited Eyam as part of their history learning.
