North Pole



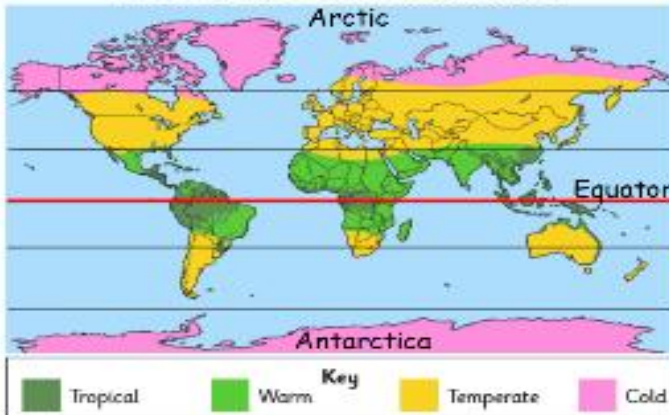
South Pole

Vocabulary

Physical features - things that are made by nature.

Human features - things built or made by people.

City - a large town.

Rivers - a large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, a lake, or another river.

Parks - a large public garden or area of land used for leisure.

Port - a town or city with a harbour, where ships load or unload.

Coast - the place where the land meets the sea.

Climate - the weather over a long period of time.

Equator - an imaginary line that runs across the middle of the world. There is hot weather at the equator.

Tropical climate - very hot and gets lots of rain.

Semi-detached house - two houses that are joined together by a wall.

Detached house - a house that is on its own.
