Deciduous trees lose their leaves in Autumn every year. Deciduous means 'fall off'.



Dandelions are wild plants.

Some plants are known as wild plants! Wild plants are not planted by humans.

Carnivores eat meat.



Some animals, like lions and tigers, are carnivores.

Herbivores eat plants.



Some animals, like cows and giraffes, are herbivores.

Omnivores eat both meat and plants.



Some animals, like foxes and humans, are omnivores.



A T-rex was a carnivore.



A diplodocus was a herbivore.



An Oviraptor was an omnivore.

Vocabulary

Carnivore - an animal that eats other animals.

Herbivore - an animal that eats plants.

Omnivore - an animal that eats a mixture of plants and animals.

Deciduous - a tree that loses its leaves in autumn every year.

Evergreen - a tree that keeps its leaves all year round.

Survive - to stay living.

Shelter - protection from the weather.

Environment - a place where something lives.

Wild - grows or lives freely.
