Focus: To talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects.

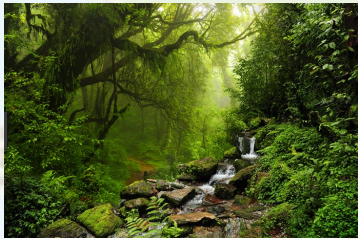
What is a habitat?

The home for an animal or plant.

What is a pet?

Habitats

Jungle- an area of land overgrown with dense forest and tangled vegetation.



Ocean- the expanse of salt water that covers most of the earth's surface and surrounded by land.



Savannah– a grassy plain in tropical and subtropical regions, with few trees.



Arctic– the area around the North Pole.

desert - A desert is a large area of land, usually in a hot place, where there is almost no water, rain, trees, or plants
