We know what the world looks like today because of explorers. They went on voyages to explore and discover lands on our planet.



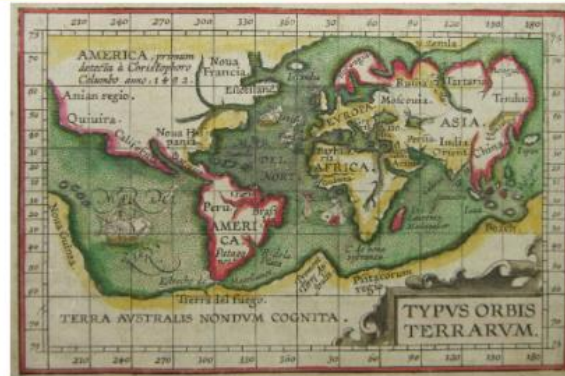
Christopher Columbus went on four voyages to America and the Caribbean.
